If you do not have Patient Access, you can either attend the surgery with Identification (one form of photo identification and one proof of address dated within the last two months) or sign up for the NHS App and register online.

YOU'RE ENTITLED TO A FREE NHS TEST IF YOU:

- are under 16 or 16, 17 or 18 and in full-time education or 60 or over
- are registered as partially sighted or blind
- have been diagnosed with diabetes or glaucoma or are 40 or over and your mother, father, sibling or child has been diagnosed with glaucoma
- have been advised that you're at risk of glaucoma
- are a prisoner on leave from prison
- are eligible for an NHS complex lens voucher
- are on eligible means-tested benefits.
